In the presentation we were all reminded of our joint responsibility to participate in this plan. All of us have benefited greatly from Saint George through the years. It's time for



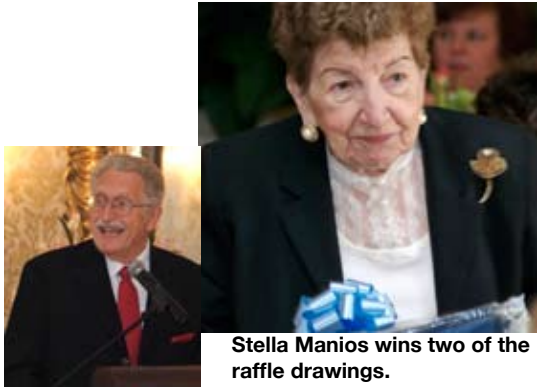
each and every one of us to meaningfully give back to our community by supporting Phase II of our Building Through Our Faith Capital Campaign.

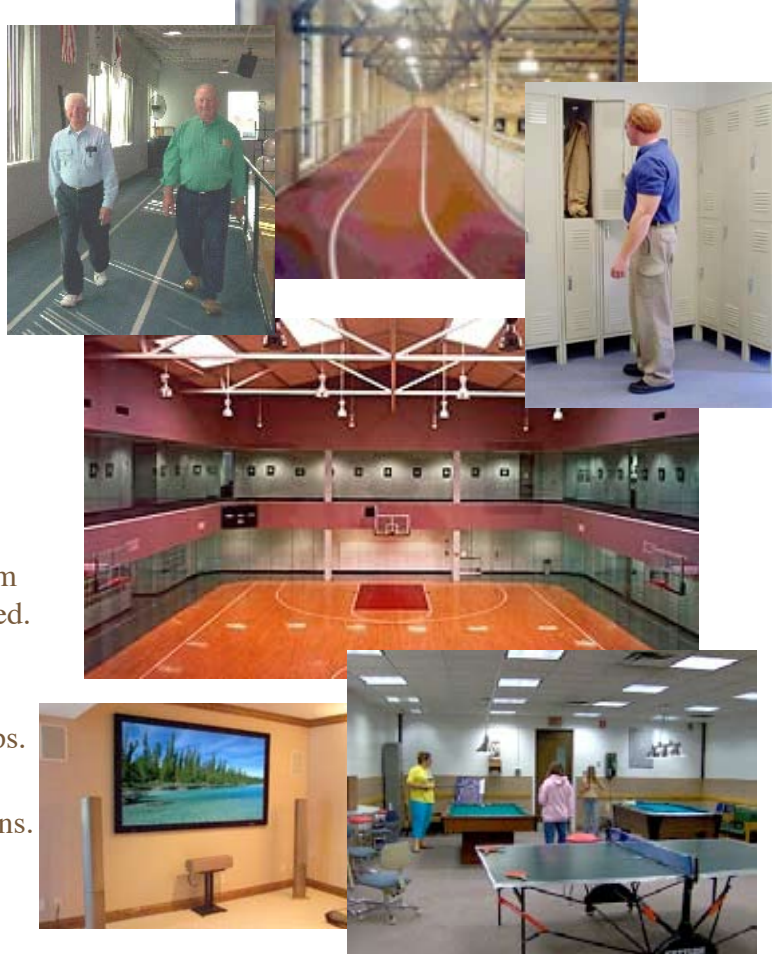
